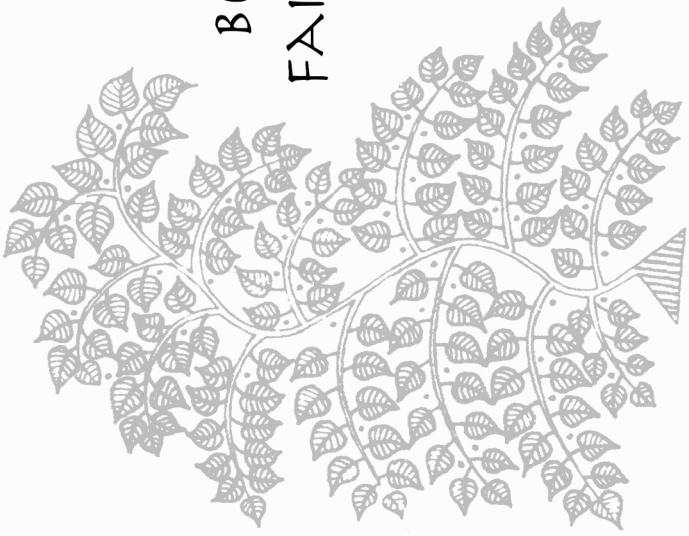

MESH works with leprosy colonies and rehabilitation workshops in villages all over India, ensuring fair wages.
